

Environmental Policy

Fizzy Fish has a strong environmental policy, principally aimed at reducing our impact on the environment.

We aim to maximise the positive impact we can have and minimise any negative impact.

We have assessed our activities, and identified issues, including but not limited to: -

- We are fully committed to recycling as much as we can on site, including cans, paper and
 plastics. We have a recycling bin that is removed by a commercial waste company twice a
 month.
- All raw vegetable waste is composited.
- All garden waste is put in a brown bin and collected by the Local Authority on a regular basis.
- We have a clinical waste contract and they collect and incinerate the waste to reduce the
 carbon emissions and therefore the impact on the environment. We place nappies directly
 into the collection bags, removing the need for nappy sacks.
- Timber from our trees is used to create habitats for insects and to make resources for the children
- We use washable clothes to clean the children after eating and messy activities, and when changing nappies.
- We aim not to use 'one use plastic' containers/bottles and individual re-usable water bottle are provided for all the staff.
- Re-useable containers and dishes are used to store and transport food, removing the need for plastic bags, clingfilm and tinfoil.
- We re-use as many things as possible including boxes and cartons for artwork and then recycling them when they are no longer need.
- We seek to comply with all relevant legislation and regulation relating to our environmental impacts.

We are constantly looking to improve our strategy. With that in mind, we are committed to reviewing our policy on a regular basis.
